TRIP OVERVIEW

Chitwan National Park Wildlife Safari is an ideal holiday destination around the lower warm areas of the Terai belt where the dense green sub-tropical jungles located. Visitors can enjoy the exciting jungle safari in the comfort of riding on an elephant. Few National Parks in Nepal are designated in the World Heritage Sites, including **Chitwan National Park.** It is also the Asia's best park for the exciting thrill of wildlife safari due to large numbers of animals and

bird species found in Chitwan National Park.

Visitors will have opportunity to observe the wild animals in their natural surroundings. Enriched with a dense tall tree lines and grassland, which makes a perfect habitat for wild mammals. During the 2-3 duration in Chitwan at Sauraha, visitors will have great thrill with various jungle and wildlife programs. From jungle to nature walks, bird watching with elephant safari and jungle drive in an open 4WD Jeep. During the safari, all jungle and nature activities are guided by professional guides and naturalists. They lead you to the heart of the jungle showing you the wonders of Chitwan National Park, exotic flora and fauna. The programs set by the hotels and lodge provide enjoyable activities to make your stay worth the experience.

Besides the wildlife safari and elusive mammals, with colorful birds like the peacocks and jungle fowl. Visitors will have the opportunity to observe the impressive local culture of the indigenous Tharu people. Chitwan National Park is a perfect tourist destination, it is also an educational field for botanist and zoology students. You will enjoy the best moments in the comfort of Sauraha hotels in Chitwan with the exciting thrill of a wildlife safari. A scenic drive brings you to Kathmandu or Pokhara after a great thrill in Chitwan National Park with an exciting **Wildlife Safari**.

ITINERARY

Day 1: Drive to Chitwan and transfer to hotel -05 hrs.

We start the morning after breakfast, for an exciting drive to Chitwan. The drive heads past Kathmandu Valley on winding downhill towards warmer foothills to follow the Trisuli River. As the journey heads further south, it reaches the lowland of Terai at Chitwan, passing the large cities of Narayanghat and Bharatpur.

From the town of Tadi, we leave the main highway and follow south through farm areas to reach Sauraha. A small town situated near the entrance of Chitwan National Park, where all the good hotels, lodges, and resorts are situated.

On arrival, you will be transferred to respective hotels for three overnights, received by the hotel manager and naturalist. After having a refreshing rest, the manager or naturalist provides brief information about jungle activities and safari as well as with do's and don'ts, then check into a nice room and enjoy a good lunch.

In the afternoon, the guide or naturalist will take you for a short nature walk or visit of the native Tharu village, to observe the cultures of the Tharu people, the main Indigenous tribe of Terai and Chitwan. In the evening, you may enjoy a slide show about Chitwan National Park's wildlife or Tharu cultural program, followed by dinner before you retire to your nice rooms.

Day 2 & 3: At Chitwan for nature, jungle activities, and safari.

The program will be conducted as per the number of guests at the hotels and as booked by Woman Adventures. The nature and jungle activities start early morning before breakfast. The guide will explain the programs, which last for a few hours, either a bird-watching, a tower visit, or an elephant safari.

The jungle and nature activities are as follows:

You will begin with a nature or bird-watching tour, as well Machan / Observation Tower visit to spot wildlife. Later, enjoy an elephant safari for a few hours within Chitwan National Park's dense jungles. After the morning activities, return to the hotel for breakfast, take a short rest, and join in for other activities. Likewise riding on a dugout canoe downstream of Rapti River, offers a pleasant float while observing the river birds, Marsh Mugger, and freshwater Gangetic Crocodiles.

After a pleasant canoe ride, enjoy a walk into the forest and back to the hotel by lunchtime. Have lunch with time to relax before heading out for more jungle activities at a given time approx. 3 p.m., such as either an elephant safari (if not already enjoyed in the morning), jungle walks, or a jungle drive. You will also have the opportunity to visit a local Tharu village and tour of Tharu museum. In the evening, enjoy either a slide show of Chitwan National Park or Tharu Cultural program before a lavish buffet dinner. On the third days, similar activities will be rotated, providing a varied and enriching experience with a mix of jungle adventures, cultural insights, and relaxation.

Day 4: Morning options for short nature activities, and drive to Kathmandu -05 hrs.

In the morning you have options for elephant safari, bird watching, or nature walks. Then back to the hotel for breakfast, and get ready for an interesting drive to Kathmandu. The drive follows the same route for more than 5 hours, depending on traffic en route to Kathmandu Valley. On reaching the city hub, you will be transferred to your hotel, after a wonderful experience on Chitwan National Park Wildlife Safari.
